IMPORTANT COVID-19 INFORMATION

DEAR GUESTS OF THE HOOD RIVER HOTEL,

FOR THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF OUR GUESTS AND OUR EMPLOYEES, AND AMID GROWING CONCERNS ABOUT THE SPREAD OF CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19), WE WANT TO SHARE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION WITH YOU ABOUT HOW THE HOOD RIVER HOTEL WILL CONTINUE TO OPERATE SAFELY AND EFFECTIVELY UNDER THE GUIDELINES FROM GOVERNOR KATE BROWN AND MAYOR OF HOOD RIVER, KATE MCBRIDE.

WE ARE CURRENTLY MANDATED BY THE CITY OF HR TO ALLOW ONLY THE FOLLOWING GUESTS UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

- REGISTERED GUESTS WHO WILL STAY FOR A MINIMUM OF 30 CONSECUTIVE DAYS.
- ESSENTIAL PERSONNEL AS DEFINED BY FEDERAL OR STATE LAW, WHERE LODGING IS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE ESSENTIAL WORK IN THE LOCAL AREA.
- INDIVIDUALS DEEMED VULNERABLE BY HOOD RIVER COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT, WHICH MAY INCLUDE BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS OR INDIVIDUALS PLACED IN QUARANTINE DUE TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY.
- OTHER INDIVIDUALS AUTHORIZED BY THE HOOD RIVER COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

ACTIONS THE HOOD RIVER HOTEL IS TAKING...

- 1. THE HOOD RIVER HOTEL IS MONITORING INFORMATION FROM THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION (CDC), ALONG WITH FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL AGENCIES TO ENSURE OUR ACTIONS ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE LATEST GUIDANCE.**
- 2. WE ARE COMMUNICATING REGULARLY WITH OUR EMPLOYEES TO KEEP THEM INFORMED AND ENSURE THEIR SAFETY AND THE SAFETY OF OUR GUESTS.**
- 3. TO COMBAT THE COVID-19 VIRUS, THE HOOD RIVER HOTEL IS CONDUCTING ENHANCED CLEANING AND DISINFECTION WITHIN OUR FACILITY PER 'CDC GUIDANCE.**
- 4. THE HOOD RIVER HOTEL ADVISES TRAVELERS TO ALSO FOLLOW 'CDC GUIDANCE TO HELP PREVENT THE TRANSMISSION OF COVID-19.**

STEPS YOU CAN TAKE...

- 1. WASH YOUR HANDS OFTEN WITH SOAP AND WATER FOR AT LEAST 20 SECONDS ESPECIALLY AFTER YOU HAVE BEEN IN A PUBLIC PLACE, AFTER BLOWING YOUR NOSE, COUGHING, OR SNEEZING. IF SOAP AND WATER ARE NOT READILY AVAILABLE, USE A HAND SANITIZER THAT CONTAINS AT LEAST 60% ALCOHOL.**
- 2. AVOID TOUCHING YOUR EYES, NOSE, AND MOUTH WITH UNWASHED HANDS.**
- 3. COVER YOUR COUGH OR SNEEZE WITH A TISSUE, THEN THROW THE TISSUE IN THE TRASH.**
- 4. STAY HOME WHEN YOU ARE SICK AND AVOID CLOSE CONTACT WITH PEOPLE WHO ARE SICK.**
